SUBJECT : Product Update for the ERZ-C 'ZNR' Transient / Surge Absorber, Leaded-type

The ERZ-C(D) 'ZNR' Transient / Surge Absorber is in the process of being discontinued.

It will be replaced with the ERZ-V Series which, through improved materials and manufacturing process, has resulted in an improved surge current handling capability (1.5 to 2.5 times when compared to the ERZ-C Series) and having lower clamping voltage for better surge protection. (look for our new product announcement for further details)

AVAILABILITY

Effective August 1, 1995, the status of the ERZ-C Series part will be changed from a 'Standard' to 'Non Cancelable / Non Refundable (NC/NR)'. The ERZ-C Series will be discontinued as of March, 1996, with the last order on October 30, 1995, and the last shipment (ex-Japan) on January 30, 1996
