- Hexavalent chromium (0.1 %)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1 %)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1 %)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1 %)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1 %)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1 %)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1 %)

Based on the information provided by our suppliers we confirm that all CONEC standard products are in compliance with Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS) and its supplements 2015/863/EU and 2017/2102/EU, also marked accordingly on packaging. Exception: few special products with special platings, which are only available upon request, are not RoHS compliant and therefore not marked.
