Re : Environmental Letter, Hazardous Substances

EPCOS supplies components ready to be used in products affected by the stipulations for banned substances of ELV (2000/53/EC) or RoHS (2002/95/EC). As to our present state of knowledge EPCOS components according to the list of RoHS compatible products published under www.epcos.com/rohs

do not contain:

1. Cadmium (Cd) and cadmium compounds
2. Chromium (VI) (Cr(VI))
3. Mercury (Hg) and mercury compounds
4. PBB (polybrominated biphenyl) category and PBDE (polybrominated diphenyl ether) category
5. Lead (Pb) and lead compounds

at a content above the maximum concentration values as defined per 2005/618/EC unless an application is exempted by Annex of RoHS (incl. amendments 2005/717/EC, 2005/747/EC, 2006/310/EC, 2006/690/EC, 2006/691/EC, 2006/692/EC).

According to 2005/618/EC from August 18th, 2005 amending Directive 2002/95/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council for the purpose of establishing the maximum concentration values for certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment a maximum concentration value of 0.1% by weight in homogeneous materials for lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) and of 0.01% by weight in homogeneous materials for cadmium shall be tolerated.
