Subject: Information Regarding Compliance with RoHS Directive Amendment (EU) 2015/863

Dear Customer:

Intel is committed to protecting the environment and complying with all hazardous substance regulations. To that end, Intel tracks the material content of our products and makes that information available to our business partners. This letter provides important information about compliance with the European Union's RoHS Directive amendment (EU) 2015/863.

The (EU) 2015/863 amends Annex II of EU RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU to add the 4 phthalates, bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP), benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP), dibutyl phthalate (DBP) and diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) onto the list of restricted substances. The restriction takes effect from July 22, 2019 for electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) products. Starting from 2019, to the best of Intel's knowledge, no products sold by Intel contain any of these 4 phthalates above 0.1% in homogeneous material.
