Murata Power Solutions Conflict Minerals Statement

Murata Power Solutions (MPS) is committed to the elimination of “Conflict Minerals” in all of its products. We are aware of the exploitation of minerals and smelting operations by various unlawful and immoral political groups to finance their objectives in countries such as the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC). We deplore all unlawful and immoral activities related to the Conflict Minerals issue, and are taking the necessary steps to prevent usage of such identified materials in our products. Further, MPS continues to monitor US Government, Japanese Government, and electronic industry actions against such activities. This includes compliance to the recent legislation passed by the United States Government concerning certain metals (Tantalum, Tin, Tungsten, and Gold) as outlined in the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Act.

While our products contain certain components which use small amounts of these metals, it is our policy to refrain from sourcing components and products from suppliers which manufacture products using these metals which cannot be traced back to legitimate mining or smelting operations in designated suspect countries.

We are working with our suppliers to have them determine their affected metals’ sources, and to certify and warrant that those metals are not being procured from mining or smelting operations known to support unlawful political groups in the DRC and surrounding regions. Through continuous monitoring and auditing procedures with our suppliers, we are taking steps to verify and ensure all components used in MPS products are Conflict-Minerals-free.
