















## **Dimensional Drawing** 4)

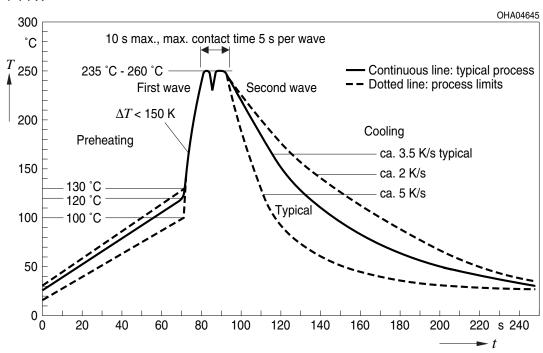

#### **Notes**
