EC directives RoHS

Dear Sir or Madam,

Thank you for your inquiry about the status of our products with respect to the EU directives RoHS.

The European directive 2002/95/EC including all related amendments – also known under the short form RoHS (Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment) - has been revised and published under the name 2011/65/EU (RoHS recast) in the Official Journal of the European Union on 07 July 2011. They restrict the use of lead, mercury, cadmium and hexavalent chromium as well as polybrominated biphenyl (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE) in electrical and electronic devices.

Herewith we like to inform you that the following requested article numbers are up to the requirements of the RoHS (EU directives 2011/65). Part number

the exemptions 6, e.g. for products of industrial connection components and exemptions 7 and 15 for products with electronic components.

We shall continue to mark all products falling into the scope of RoHS II or meeting the substance requirements with the known logo, e.g. in e-Shop and on the outer packaging:



The logo with the lettering "RoHS WEEE Compliant" thus **does not represent any warranty of product features** and does not indicate the inclusion into the CE procedure as required by RoHS II, they marked correspondingly.

In the event that legal requirements concerning the existing exemptions, additional substances or stricter limit values will be published in the future, Phoenix Contact will implement them in due time as far as these are or will depend on the individual possibility of substitution and the technical feasibility.
