






(1) IN (BASE)(2) GND (+) (EMITTER)(3) OUT (COLLECTOR)

Fig.1 Input voltage vs. output current (ON characteristics)




Fig.2 Output current vs. input voltage (OFF characteristics)




Fig.3 Output current vs. output voltage






Fig.4 DC current gain vs. output current



OUTPUT CURRENT :  $I_{o}$  [A]



## Fig.5 Output voltage vs. output current





#### Precaution for Mounting / Circuit board design
