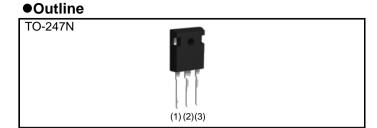

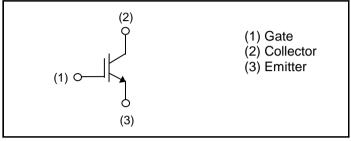

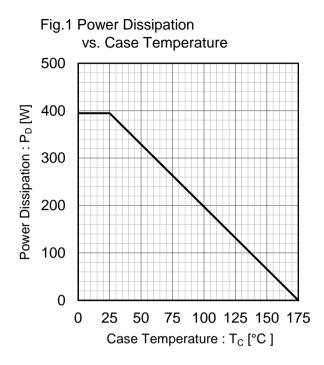


Fig.2 Collector Current vs. Case Temperature 60 50 Collector Current : Ic [A] 40 30 20 10 T_j ≤ 175°C V_{GE} ≥ 15V 0 25 50 75 100 125 150 175 0 Case Temperature : T_C [°C]

Fig.3 Forward Bias Safe Operating Area

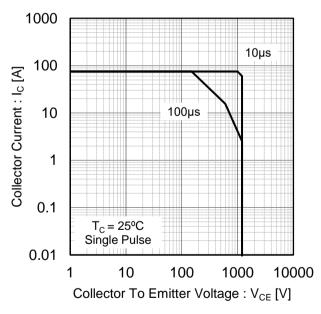
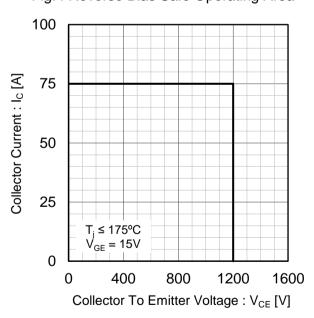


Fig.4 Reverse Bias Safe Operating Area

Fig.5 Typical Output Characteristics

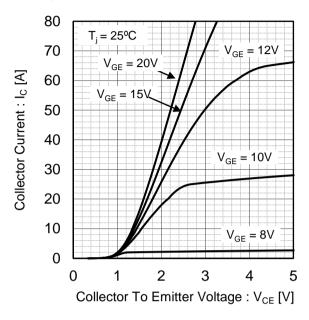


Fig.6 Typical Output Characteristics

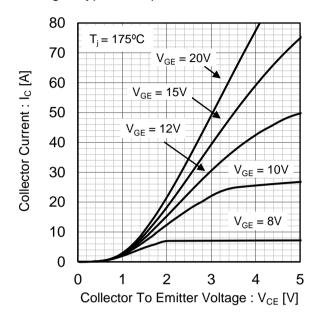


Fig.7 Typical Transfer Characteristics

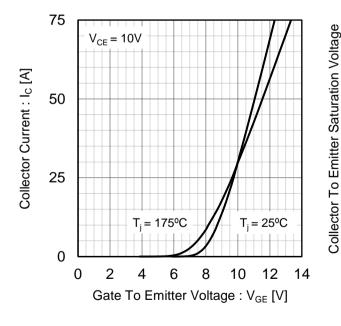
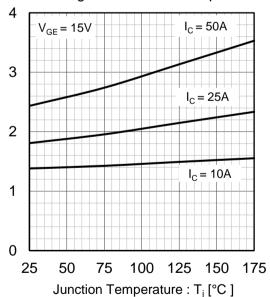


Fig.8 Typical Collector To Emitter Saturation

Fig.9 Typical Collector To Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Gate To Emitter Voltage

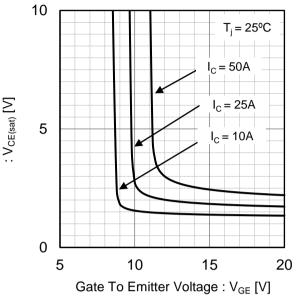


Fig.10 Typical Collector To Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Gate To Emitter Voltage

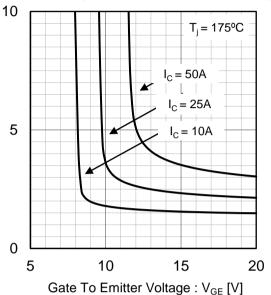


Fig.11 Typical Switching Time vs. Collector Current

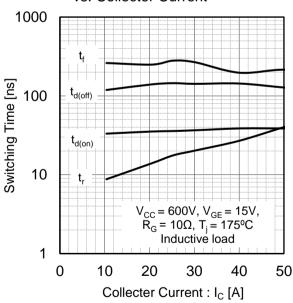
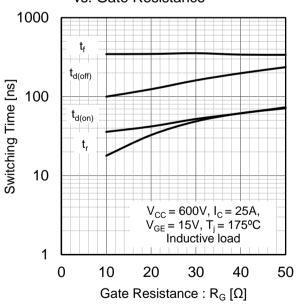


Fig.12 Typical Switching Time vs. Gate Resistance

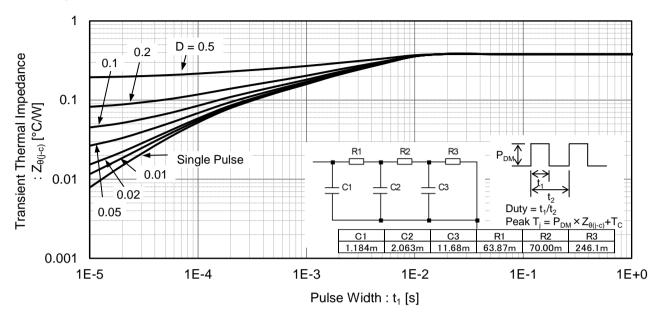
Fig.15 Typical Capacitance vs. Collector To Emitter Voltage 10000 C_{ies} 1000 Capacitance [pF] $\mathsf{C}_{\mathsf{oes}}$ 100 10 f = 1MHz $\mathsf{C}_{\mathsf{res}}$ $V_{GE} = 0V$ $T_i = 25^{\circ}C$ 1 0.01 0.1 10 100 Collector To Emitter Voltage: V_{CE} [V]

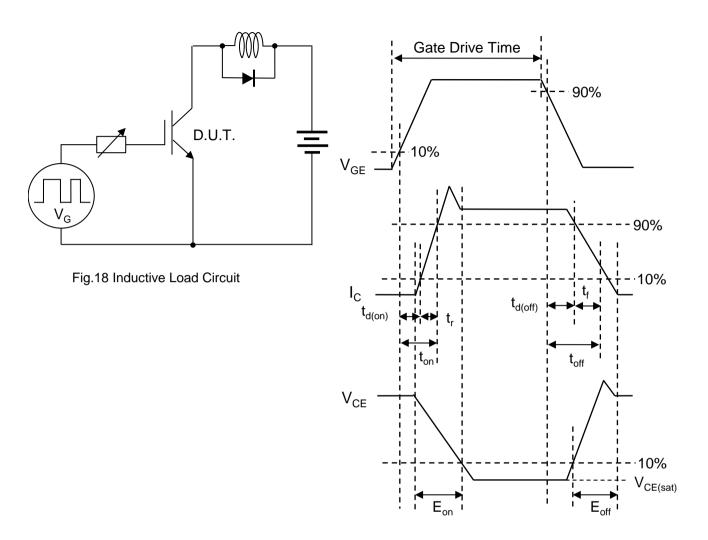


Fig.19 Inductive Load Waveform

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
