

# High power transient voltage suppressor

### **Features**



## **Description**

The ESDA15P60-1U1M is an unidirectional single line TVS diode designed to protect the power line against EOS and ESD transients.






Figure 4: Peak pulse power versus exponential pulse duration (T<sub>j</sub> initial = 25°C) (typ. value)





Figure 7: ESD response to IEC 61000-4-2 (+8kV contact discharge)

Figure 9: QFN 1610 package outline






Product marking may be rotated by multiples of 90° for assembly plant differentiation. In no case should this product marking be used to orient the component for its placement on a PCB. Only pin 1 mark is to be used for this purpose.




### 3 Recommendation PCB

## 3.1 Stencil opening

- 1. General recommendation on stencil opening design
  - a. Stencil opening dimensions: L (Length), W (Width), T (Thickness).
- 2. General design rule
  - a. Stencil thickness (T) = 75  $\sim$  125  $\mu$ m
  - b. Aspect ratio =  $\frac{W}{T} \ge 1.5$
  - c. Aspect area =  $\frac{L \times W}{2T(L+W)} \ge 0.66$
- 3. Reference design
  - a. Stencil opening thickness: 100 µm
  - b. Stencil opening for leads: Opening to footprint ratio is 90%.





## 3.2 Solder paste

- 1. Use halide-free flux, qualification ROL0 according to ANSI/J-STD-004.
- 2. "No clean" solder paste is recommended.
- 3. Offers a high tack force to resist component movement during PCB movement.
- 4. Solder paste with fine particles: powder particle size is 20-45 μm.

#### 3.3 **Placement**

- Manual positioning is not recommended.
- 2. It is recommended to use the lead recognition capabilities of the placement system, not the outline centering
- 3. Standard tolerance of ±0.05 mm is recommended.
- 3.5 N placement force is recommended. Too much placement force can lead to squeezed out solder paste and cause solder joints to short. Too low placement force can lead to insufficient contact between package and solder paste that could cause open solder joints or badly centered packages.
- To improve the package placement accuracy, a bottom side optical control should be 5. performed with a high resolution tool.
- 6. For assembly, a perfect supporting of the PCB (all the more on flexible PCB) is recommended during solder paste printing, pick and place and reflow soldering by using optimized tools.

#### 3.4 PCB design preference

- To control the solder paste amount, the closed via is recommended instead of open
- The position of tracks and open vias in the solder area should be well balanced. A symmetrical layout is recommended, to avoid any tilt phenomena caused by asymmetrical solder paste due to solder flow away.

#### 3.5 Reflow




Figure 17: ST ECOPACK® recommended soldering reflow profile for PCB mounting




Minimize air convection currents in the reflow oven to avoid component movement.
