

Certificate of Compliance

TO:

Starting July 2006, all producers of electronic and electrical equipment manufactured and sold in Europe or imported or exported into or from a country member of the EU, must comply with the EU's Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive 2002/95/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 January 2003. The RoHS Directive mandates the maximum concentration level of six hazardous materials-Lead (Pb), Hexavalent chromium (Cr+6), Mercury (Hg), Cadmium (Cd), PolyBrominated Biphenyls (PBB) and PolyBrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE).

This document serves to indicate that STMicroelectronics conforms to the requirements of the RoHS Directive and that products you have ordered and supplied to you by STMicroelectronics or an authorized ST Distributor are compliant with the RoHS Directive.
