











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





Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage

On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature





On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage


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




### Threshold Voltage Variance vs. Temperature



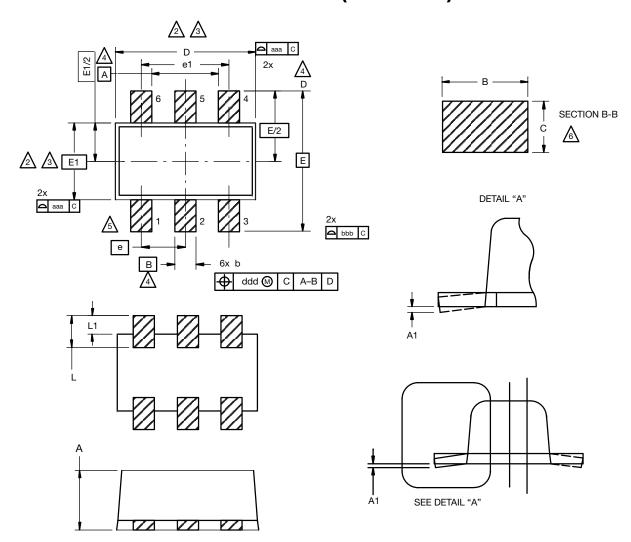

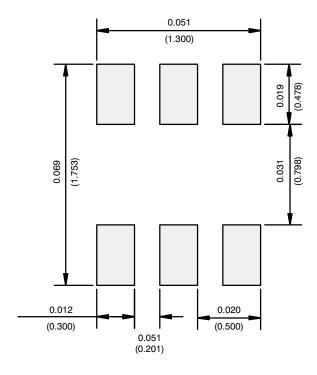
